Upcoming Renewals and Expirations

Our big deals expire at the end of each year. You do not have to renew, even if we are in a multi-year deal, but you may be required to provide advance notice of non-renewal. See the CC Box account for details.

Many of our EBSCO subscriptions expire 12/31. Within the next few weeks, we will send out pricing and set a renewal/cancel notification deadline.

The Elsevier invoices sent to College Edition subscribers in early October erroneously contained a 3% increase. They will be sending new, corrected invoices soon.

NEWS AND UPDATES

We have finalized terms for all of the “Big 6” publishers for 2021 - Cambridge, Elsevier, Oxford, SAGE, SpringerNature, and Wiley.

Beginning in 2021, our Cambridge big deal will allow most subscribing institutions the ability to have their faculty-authored articles appear as OA in all Cambridge journals. The CC is a very early adopter of this new approach. Within the United States, only the UC System currently has an uncapped, multi-institutional deal of this type.

VENDOR/PUBLISHER PARTNER WEBINARS

Because the 2020 in-person CC meeting was cancelled, we lost our usual opportunity for interaction between CC librarians and our partners. So, we are instead offering our partners the opportunity to host a CC webinar some time during the Fall semester.
